5. Entries : Preliminary entry (by event and numbers) – Form MFF 1.

This form has to be received by the organizing committee

not later than 18th June 2018.

Final entry (by name) – Form MFF 2 and MFF 3.

These two forms have to reach the organizing committee not later

than **30th June 2018**.

Transport request form – Form MFF 4.

This form must reach the organizing committee by 30th June 2018.

6. Competition Rules: The fencing competition shall be conducted in accordance with the current statues and rules of FIE. In case of disagreements

in interpretation of the rules, the latest FIE rules in the English version shall prevail. The Directoire de' Technique shall deal with

any unforeseen incidents not covered by the rules.

7. Equipment : FIE equipments are not compulsory, however, rusty weapons, torn

fencing attire and short socks are not allowed. Fencer's clothing must be made of sufficiently, robust material and should be in good condition. **An inner plastron is compulsary**. Weapon check will

be done on the piste before each bout.

8. Competition Management:

(8.1) Referee

Participating delegations must be accompanied by number of referees according to the FIE Rules as follows:

> 1-4 fencers : 0 referee 5-9 fencers : 1 referee 10 or more fencers : 2 referees

Note: Please ensure that the referees are to be properly attired.

Please bring a jacket / blazer and long pants.

If the participating delegation fails to provide the required number of referees, a penalty fee of RM400.00 / per day / per referee will be imposed. The fee should be payed before the start of the competition on the day

(8.2) Directoire de Technique (DT)

The DT will be responsible for the technical organisation of the competition.

(8.3) Jury of appeal

The jury of appeal will consist of one representative for each participating country / state / club under the chairmanship of the Organising Chairman, or a representative appointed by him. The decision of the jury of appeal shall be final.

(8.4) Protests

Appeals against decisions of the referee should be immediately made by the competitors to the referee, before any decisions are made regarding the subsequent hit. If the referee could not maintain his decision, the complaint will be brought to the attention of the D.T. Every appeal to the jury of hit appeal must be accompanied by a deposit of USD 200.00 which will not be refundable. This sum will be confiscated in whole or in part if the appeal is rejected by jury of appeal. Appeals must be lodged and written in Bahasa Malaysia and / or English.

: A medal will be awarded to the 1st, 2nd and joint 3rd places in 9. Prizes

each event.

10. Entry Fees : Individual Event - USD 45 per person / per event..

> Entry fees can be paid during the team manager's meeting by cash. Kindly be reminded that all fees must be paid before the start

of the competition.

11. Accommodation:

The official hotel during the competition is the **Olympic Sports Hotel Kuala Lumpur**. The hotel is attached to the competition hall and is located conveniently in the city centre. Teams are recommended to make booking arrangements directly with the hotel to get the best rates available.

12. Transportation:

Transportation to and from the official hotel can be arranged for delegations who will be arriving / departing at the same time, in a minumum group of 8 people or more. The fee for the transportation is as follows:-

- Van (max occupancy 7 8 pax) = USD 80 (one way)
- Bus (max occupancy 20 25 pax) = USD200 (one way)

The participants will need to fill in **FORM MFF 4** to arrange with the MFF organiser for transportation. This service will only be available from 5th - 9th July 2018. The transportation will only travel to/from the official hotel only from Kuala Lumpur International Airport (KLIA) & KLIA2.
