Participation

Each country can field as many entries they want in the Individual Events but in the Team Events each country can field only a maximum 2 teams per event. However, the host country can field a maximum of 4 teams in each event team event.

Deadline of Entries

- Preliminary Entry (by event and number) Form 1 by March 16, 2015
- Final Entry (by event and name) Form 2 & 3 by April 13, 2015

Competition Method

The fencing competition shall be conducted in accordance with the current Statutes and Rules of the FIE. In case of disagreement in the interpretation of the Rules, the latest English version shall prevail. The Directoire Technique shall deal with any unforeseen incidents not covered by the Rules.

Equipments

It is compulsory for all fencers to wear 350N for jacket and breeches, 800N for underplastron and long socks. Mask with conductive bib for foil is required.

All equipment must be submitted for weapons testing and must passed the weapons check by the Organizers before they may be used in the competition.

Referees

Each country participating in the competition must be accompanied by a number of referees according to the following formula:

- 1 4 fencers (no referees required)
- 5 9 fencers (1 referee required)
- 10 or more fencers (2 referees required)

Countries with no available referee will be asked to pay \$100.00 per day during the duration of the competition

Prizes

- (a) Individual events, One (1) Gold, One (1) Silver and Two (2) Bronze medals to the top four (4) fencers in the SEA- Pacific Fencing Championships
- (b) Individual events, One (1) Gold, One (1) Silver and Two (2) Bronze medals to the top four (4) fencers in the ASEAN Fencing Championships.
- (c) Team events, four (4) Gold medals for the champion team, Four (4) Silver medals for the second placed team, and two (2) sets of four (4) Bronze medals for the two losing teams in the semi-finals in the SEA- Pacific Fencing Championships
- (d) Team events four (4) Gold medals for the champion team, Four (4) Silver medals for the second placed team, and two (2) sets of four (4) Bronze medals for the two losing teams in the semi-finals in the ASEAN Fencing Championships.

Entry Fees, Accommodation & Meals

The entry fee is US\$40.00 per person per individual event and US\$100.00 per team per event.

Official Hotels:

(a) Five Star Hotel

Single/Twin: US\$140.00/room/night

(b) Four Star Hotel

Single/Twin: US \$110.00/room/night

Triple:US\$145.00/room/night

Two-way airport transfers, daily two-way venue transfers and daily Buffet Breakfast are included in the above rates. Transportation will be provided by the organizers and available ONLY to all participants who will stay at the official hotels and arranged by the organizers

Payment of entry fees and accommodations are to be paid in cash by April 19, 2015 after the Team Managers' Meeting.

Language

The official language of the SEA-Pacific Fencing Championships and ASEAN Fencing Championships is English

Entry Formalization

Everyone entering the Philippines must possess valid passports, participants are recommended to check with their local Philippine Embassy for visa requirements before traveling.

General Information

(i) Currency

Philippines unit of currency is the Philippine Peso (Php). Foreign currency can be exchanged freely at banks, hotels, the airport and most big shopping malls. Current exchange rate is approximately PhP44.50 to USD1.00. Major credit cards are widely accepted in most establishments.

(ii) Weather & Dress

The Philippines has a warm and humid climate throughout the year with a daily average temperature range of 26"C to 38"C. Light clothing is best for everyday wear.

(iii) Electricity

The Philippines voltage is 220-240 volts AC, 50 Hz.
