



4th ASEAN UNIVERSITY FENCING CHAMPIONSHIP (AUFC) 2020

1. Date: 5th – 8th March 2020 (Thursday to Sunday)

2. Venue: President Hall, Nilai University, Nilai, Negeri Sembilan, MALAYSIA.

3. Organizers:

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4. This Championship is supported by the Sports Unit of the Ministry of Education Malaysia (MOE) and ASEAN University Sports Council (AUSC)

5. Championship Schedule: (Please refer schedule on page 6)

6. Participants:

- 6.1** Each university is only allowed to register 6 fencers per individual event per gender. However, maximum number will be 64 entries for each individual event per gender (first come first serve basis).
- 6.2** For team events, only Men's and Women's Epee will be contested. Each university is only allowed to register one (1) team for each category. Each team shall comprise of three (3) fencers and one (1) reserve fencer.
- 6.3** If any participating team do not have enough participant to participate in team event, they are allowed to form a mixed team (same gender). A mixed team should give a proper name to their team (i.e: Zorro, Musketeers & etc) in order for them to participate in team event. Please take note that maximum allowable teams per gender are 8 teams.



- 6.4 There will be no limit to the numbers of entries from the organizer. The organizer also reserves the right to invite any university team outside the ASEAN region.**

7. Entries:

- 7.1 Preliminary Entry (by event and number) – Form B1:** This form must reach the organizing committee not later than **24th January 2020 (Friday)**.
- 7.2 Final Entry (by name) – Form B2A & Form B2B:** These two forms have to reach the organizing committee not later than **14th February 2020 (Friday)**.

8. Championship Rules

- 8.1** The competition will be fenced according to the FIE rules. However, there will be **two (2) categories** in Individual Events which are the **Open University category and ASEAN University category**.
- 8.2** All fencers will be registered for the Open University Category. Please take note that this championship will not be separated. Winners will be based on the final overall ranking only.
- 8.3** For example, top 4 fencers (1st place, 2nd place & joint 3rd places) from the final overall ranking are the winners in Open University category. If it is won by non ASEAN fencers then the best rankings of the ASEAN fencer will get the prize of ASEAN category. If a fencer from ASEAN University has won (1st place OR 2nd place OR joint 3rd places) in an Open University Category, he or she **WILL** not be entitled to win any more cash prizes and medals in the ASEAN University Category and the organizer has the rights to keep his/her prizes (ASEAN University fencer will only get one prize which is his/her best ranking between the two (2) categories).



- 8.4** If the winners are not present during the prize giving ceremony without any representative, the organizer will have the right not to present the cash prizes and medals after the competition has ended.

9. Equipment:

FIE equipment is not compulsory, however, rusty weapons, torn uniforms and short socks are not allowed. The fencing jacket, breeches and inner plastron should be N350 or higher grade of materials. An inner plastron is compulsory (preferably 800 NW). Weapon check will be done on the piste before each bout.

10. Championship Management

- 10.1** Participating delegation must be accompanied by the number of referees according to the rules as follows:-

1 – 4 fencers	: 0 referee
5 – 9 fencers	: 1 referee
10 and more fencers	: 2 referees

University who do not send any referee in accordance with this rules will be fined RM 100.00 per referee. All referees should wear black jackets.

10.2 Directoire Technique (DT)

The Directoire Technique (DT) will be responsible for the organization of the competition. The members shall consist of three (3) representatives from the organizer.

10.3 Protest

Every appeal to the Directoire Technique (DT) must be accompanied with a deposit of US\$200.00. This sum will be confiscated in whole if the appeal is rejected by the DT. Appeals must be lodged and written in English within 5 minutes (maximum) after completion of the bout.

11. Certificate, Medal & Prize Money:

- 11.1** Medals will be awarded to the 1st, 2nd and joint 3rd places in both Open and ASEAN University category. Participation certificates will be given to all participants.

- 11.2** As for the cash prizes **(Individual Events only)**, winners will be awarded based on their categories:



11.2.1 For Open University category:

- 1st place - RM500.00
- 2nd place - RM300.00
- 3rd place - RM100.00 each X 2 pax

11.2.2 For ASEAN University category:

- 1st place - RM500.00
- 2nd place - RM300.00
- 3rd place - RM100.00 each X 2 pax

12. Entry Fee:

- Individual events - RM100.00 per fencer per event
- Team events - RM300.00 per team
