Participation	<ul style="list-style-type: none">★ Maximum 10 overseas fencers for each individual event by national federation;★ Maximum 10 fencers for each individual event by fencing club in mainland China;★ Junior events – Participants must be born from 2006 to 2011;★ Cadet events – Participants must be born from 2009 to 2012;★ Entry fee is non-transferable and non-refundable in any circumstances;★ Cadet participants can compete in both Cadet and Junior events;★ The results of oversea fencers will not be yielded points towards HK representation for all categories.
Entry Fee (For Non-HKID fencer)	Individual: US\$65 per entry (or \$500 HKD) Payment of cash upon registration on-site

Fencing Equipment	<ul style="list-style-type: none">★ Full fencing uniform and gear must be prepared by the participant. The mask and uniform must comply with the standard EN13567:2002 and 350N of the min. penetration resistance force. The mask must have two independent security devices.★ All participants must wear an 800N under-plastron which conforms to the FIE rules for taking part in the competition.★ Please refer to the relevant notices posted on our webpage at http://www.hkfa.org.hk for details.★ The ground supervisor shall disqualify any participant who doesn't comply with the uniform rules.★ Weapon Check will be held in the competition venue.
Referee	<p>Each country/ region / fencing club (mainland China only) should bring referee(s) at their expenses in the following ratio:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- 1 -4 fencers /day= no referee required- 5 -9 fencers /day= 1 referee- 10-15 fencers/day = 2 referees- 16+ fencers/day = 3 referees <p>Required number of referees is not respected, a fine will be charged US\$500 per day per referee. (Max 2days)</p>
Prizes	Individual events: one (1) Gold, one (1) Silver, and two (2) Bronze medals to the top four (4) fencers
